## Volunteer Commitment Expectations

The following are the Volunteer commitment expectations.

- 5+ hours per month of work

- Communicate regularly and often with the persons within your respective Committee
  - Volunteers are asked to respond to communication within 24 hours
- Communicate any Committee concerns to your Committee Leader and/or the President's Circle
- Contribute to goals and outcomes within your Committee
- Be open to developmental feedback
- Provide insight, ideas, collaboration, feedback, etc. to projects, initiatives, deliverables, where and when appropriate
